To improve network safety, service reliability and to reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we will be undertaking various track maintenance activities on the network.

How this affects you

Noise and traffic impact

- Works will take place on Monday 11 and Tuesday 12 April, nightly from 11:30pm to 5am. Works will finish on Wednesday 13 April at 5am.
- Residents and retailers may hear noise associated with on-site activities, including the operations of track maintenance vehicles.
- Work may take place on adjacent footpaths, at intersections, on cross streets and side streets around the area.
- Floodlights may be used during the work period but directed away from residential areas.
- Workers may access the site before and after the works period to set-up and remove equipment.
- While workers will park their vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.

We understand these works can impact you and your neighbours and would like to thank you for your patience and cooperation in helping us ensure the safety of the community. The NSW Environment Protection Authority will be notified of these works.
