What we are doing

To maintain network safety, service reliability and to reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we will be undertaking track maintenance on the network.

How this affects you

Noise and traffic impact

- Work will take place **each night from Monday 1 to Thursday 4 December, between 10:30pm and 5am.**
- Residents and retailers may hear noise associated with the use of vehicles, cranes, generators, and tools to complete the work.
- Work may take place on adjacent footpaths, at intersections, on cross streets and side streets around the area.
- Floodlights may be used but directed away from residential areas.
- Workers may access the site before and after the works period to set-up and remove equipment.
- While workers will park their vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.

We understand this work can impact you and your neighbours and would like to thank you for your patience. The NSW Environment Protection Authority will be notified of this work.

L2 Randwick and L3 Kingsford Lines weeknight full closures due to maintenance

From **Monday 1 to Wednesday 3 December**, nightly from 9pm to 1am, L2 Randwick and L3 Kingsford Lines light rail services will not run due to planned trackwork and maintenance works.

During this time, use alternative transport including:

- Replacement bus services or regular bus services between **Central Chalmers Street** and **Randwick** or **Juniors Kingsford**,
- Train services, bus services or walking if able to, between **Circular Quay** and **Central Chalmers Street**.
- Please note on Monday 1 and Tuesday 2 December, from 9.40pm to 1.30am, trains will not run on the City Circle. Replacement buses will run between Central, Museum, St James and Circular Quay.

Allow extra travel time and use the Trip Planner or check travel alerts to see if your travel is affected.
