From Saturday 18 to Monday 20 July

What we are doing

To maintain network safety, service reliability, and to reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we will be undertaking track maintenance on the network.

How this affects you

Noise and traffic impact

- Work will take place **from 1am Saturday 18 July to 5am Monday 20 July 2026**.
- Residents and retailers may hear noise associated with the use of vehicles, cranes, generators, and tools to complete the work.
- Work may take place on adjacent footpaths, at intersections, on cross streets and side streets around the area.
- Floodlights may be used but directed away from residential areas.
- Workers may access the site before and after the works period to set up and remove equipment.
- While workers will park their vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.

We understand this work can impact you and your neighbours and would like to thank you for your patience. The NSW Environment Protection Authority will be notified of this work.

Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 July, L2 Randwick and L3 Kingsford Lines light rail services will not run due to planned trackwork.

- Replacement bus services or regular bus services between **Central Chalmers Street** and **Randwick** or **Juniors Kingsford**,
- Trains, buses, or walk if able to, between **Circular Quay** and **Central Chalmers Street**.
